The undersigned is directed to refer to your letter no. nil dated 06.03.2019 regarding clearance of this Ministry for the above mentioned event. In this connection, it is clarified that 'No Objection' of MHA is conveyed to the organiser for obtaining appropriate Visa for foreign participants in the specified events i.e. Conference/Seminar/Workshop /Sports events. For that purpose, participants from concerned countries need to apply for 'Conference Visa'. However, as the above event is not covered under the above categories, no event clearance is required for this purpose. The foreign nationals participating in the event may be advised to apply for 'appropriate visa' from the concerned Indian Missions abroad.

2. "Ministry of Home Affairs has launched an online event clearance platform (<https://conference.mha.gov.in>) for grant of security clearance for organizing an event. Necessary instruction in this regards is annexed as Annexure-'A' for reference and future compliance. It is further intimated that no request for grant of security clearance for conduct of events in offline mode will be entertained after 30.09.2018."
